## Part-Time Teaching Position: Sessional Lecturer ECED 490 Faculty Advising (Online)

### Position Description

The Early Childhood Education Program in the UBC Faculty of Education invites applications from early childhood educators with expertise in early years education (including preschool, childcare, kindergarten and primary grades) for a part-time faculty advisor position (as Sessional Lecturer) commencing in September 2023 with practicum supervision in various Lower Mainland early childhood education settings. Expectations include at least one on site visit to practicum site (mileage reimburses), additional visits if required based on student and site needs, classroom observation, lead three online practicum seminars, student feedback sessions, final reports, assignment grading.

Term: 2023 Winter Term 1 (September 12 – October 31, 2023)

ECED 490 is the first practicum experience for students completing a program of studies leading towards BC ECE Basic Certification. Credit weight is commensurate with the number of students supervised. Number of students is pending.

### Qualifications

Candidates must have a recognized Master's degree in Early Childhood Education or related field, a minimum of 3 years of recent teaching experience in an early childhood setting, experience acting as a mentor, excellent communication skills, and a disposition toward inquiry and communicative teaching and learning. Preference will be given to those with a record of excellence in teaching in early childhood settings in British Columbia. Knowledge of current curriculum developments (e.g., BC Early Learning Framework) and early childhood pedagogical approaches is highly desirable.
